

Bible Verse Footprints

Use the following footprint pages to teach a Bible verse in a new way. Each footprint has a word from a verse.

Instructions

Print the pages and tape them to the floor in order. Students will walk on the words when they enter the classroom or when you want to teach the verse.

If you have a special destination in the classroom, like the food table for example, make the footprints lead from the door to the table. Try other arrangements such as taping the footprints to wall or ceiling.

Make your own verse

Page 2 and 3 are blank footprints. Print these two pages multiple times and write your own words on them with a marker. The example verse in this project is Revelation 1:3.

If your verse (or chapter) is very long, write more than one word on each footprint.

Make the activity a class project by asking the students to create their own verse trail.
