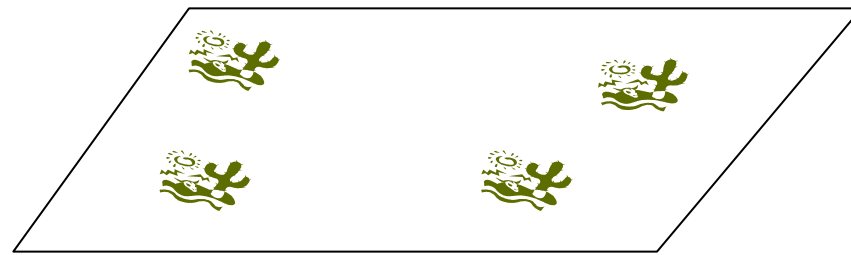
1. Print pages 2 and 3 of this file.

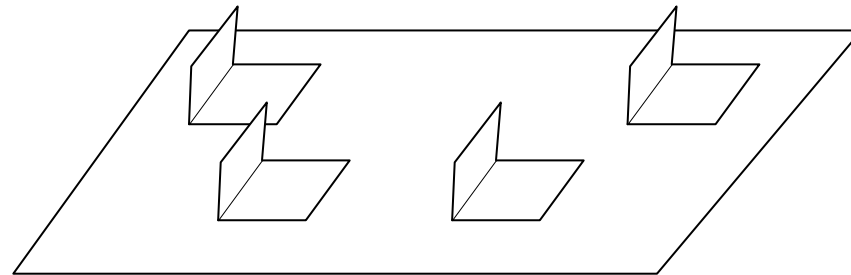

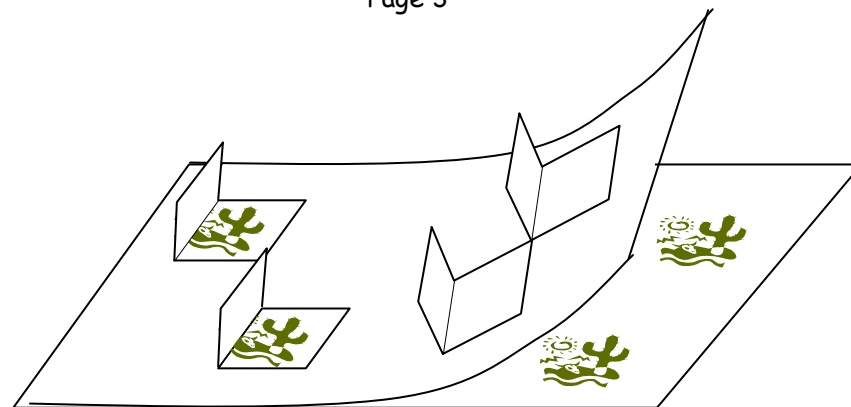

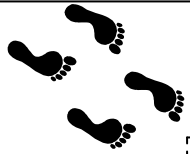
