The Two Roads—A map to eternity

With this Bible class project, you can 6) create a road map of the journey of a soul from birth to death and beyond.

The Two Roads and Two Destinies is a chart based on Matthew 7:13-14 "Enter by the narrow gate. For the gate is wide and the way is easy that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many. For the gate is narrow and the way is hard that leads to life, and those who find it are few "

After examining the map ask your students the following questions and discuss the following verses...

- Which road do people start on? Romans 3:23 "For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God."
- 2) Who is the door? John 10:9 "I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved"
- 3) Does everyone die? Hebrews 9:27 "it is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes judgment"
- 4) What is the final judgment for those who die in their sins? "if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire" Revelation 20:15.
- What kind of evaluation is there for a 2) saved person in Heaven? "If the work that anyone has built on the foun-

dation survives, he will receive a reward. If anyone's work is burned up, he will suffer loss, though he himself will be saved, but only as through fire." 1 Corinthians 3:14-15.


Directions:

- Fold and tape them as shown in the photo below.
















These three shapes are the "pages" of the books. You can just see the pages on the white book in the photo.
