



# Samuel the Prophet— Mini Books and Pictures


## How to fold 8 page booklet

### Directions:


1. Read the first eight chapters of 1 Samuel. There is a lot of detail in the chapters that is not included in this mini book.
2. Print the pages of your choice. Page 2 is a mini book with 8 pages. Pages 3 through 9 are full-sized pictures suitable for coloring or for telling a story on a classroom wall.
3. Folding instructions: For the 8 page booklet, start by folding the page in half the long way first.
4. Use the booklets and pictures to tell the story and then as a coloring project for the last few minutes of class. At the end of class, send the students home with a story to tell their parents and friends.

Fold the center and bend backwards.



The final booklet is an accordion-style book.
